Terry Kottman, Ph.D., Registered Play Therapist-Supervisor, NCC, LMHC, founded The Encouragement Zone, a center where she provides play therapy training, life coaching, "playsshops" for women, and play therapy supervision. She regularly presents entertaining and engaging experiential workshops on play therapy; adventure therapy; activity-based counseling; counseling for children, adolescents, and their parents; consultation with teachers; and coaching adults. Prior to founding The Encouragement Zone, Terry spent eight years as a professor of counselor education at the University of Northern Iowa in Cedar Falls, Iowa, and five years as a professor of counselor education and director of the Child and Family Resource Clinic at the University of North Texas in Denton, Texas. In 2014, Terry was honored to receive the Lifetime Achievement Award from the Association of Play Therapy. In 2017, she received a Lifetime Achievement Award from the Iowa Association for Play Therapy.

3. Use Adlerian play therapy conceptualization tools for understanding how trauma has had an impact on clients' lifestyles.
4. Describe 5 strategies for activating clients' parasympathetic nervous system.
5. Describe 5 principles of trauma-informed therapy with children and adolescents.
6. Describe the process of using sensor-motor art processes and/or sensory image drawings with traumatized clients in play therapy.
