Dr. Eliana Gil is a psychotherapist currently in private practice at Gil Center for Healing and Play in Fairfax, Virginia. She is also director of Starbright Training Institute, providing training in child and family play therapy as well as childhood trauma. Dr. Gil is a Registered Play Therapy Supervisor, Registered Art Therapist, and a licensed Marital and Family Therapist. She has served on the board of directors of the American Professional Society on the Abuse of Children, the National Resource Center on Child Sexual Abuse, and is a former president of the Association for Play Therapy. She has produced numerous written and video materials on child abuse and related topics. Some of her books include *Cultural Issues in Play Therapy*; *Treating Abused Adolescents*; *Systemic Treatment of Families who Abuse*; *The Healing Power of Play*; *Play in Family Therapy*; and her most recent books are: *Healing interpersonal trauma: The healing power of play* and *Helping Abused and Traumatized Children: Integrating Directive and Nondirective Approaches*. Dr. Gil is a well-known lecturer, author and clinician. She is bilingual and bicultural, originally from Ecuador. She conducts trainings throughout the U.S. and abroad. This year marks 38 years that she has worked in child abuse prevention and treatment.

## **Integrated Play Therapy with Abused and Traumatized Children**

**April 15, 2011**

This workshop will provide state-of-the-art information regarding the impact of trauma on children’s development, common issues and concerns, and special areas for attention. A child-friendly assessment process will be discussed as well as a phase-specific treatment model with specific play therapy interventions designed to promote each goal. Post-trauma play as a child’s natural way of achieving gradual exposure will be discussed. A combination of lecture, case examples, and experiential work will be available throughout the day. Emphasis will be placed on utilizing an integrated approach that engages children and elicits more full participation in treatment.

### **Directions**

#### **FROM THE EAST**

Follow Roswell Road, crossing over Cobb Parkway (Hwy. 41) and passing the Big Chicken on your right. The Mansour Center is on Roswell, one block past Cobb Parkway on the right.

#### **FROM THE WEST**

Follow Dallas Highway, traveling east, as it becomes Whitlock Avenue. Continue on Whitlock through the Marietta Square. Whitlock will become Roswell Street. Follow Roswell Street to the Mansour Center, which will be on the left, one block before Cobb Parkway (Hwy. 41).

#### **FROM THE NORTH**

Follow Cobb Parkway (Hwy. 41) south to Roswell Street (the Big Chicken). Turn right onto Roswell, and the Mansour Center is one block on the right.

#### **FROM THE SOUTH**

Travel north on I-75 toward Marietta/Chattanooga. Take exit 263 (Marietta/Roswell) and bear left onto the west ramp to Marietta/Southern Poly. This will lead to South Marietta Parkway (120 Loop West). Follow South Marietta Parkway west to Cobb Parkway (Hwy. 41) and turn right. Go north to Roswell Street (the Big Chicken) and turn left. The Mansour Center is one block on the right.
